who volunteered with the team throughout the years. He was a lifetime member of the Commodore's Board of Directors and team historian. In 2019 Al attended his last Falmouth Commodore game by throwing out the first pitch. Al Irish passed away on February 20, 2021 at the age of 101.

# FALMOUTH COMMODORES AND CAPE COD BASEBALL LEAGUE (CCBL) DOMINATE 2020 MLB DRAFT

The 2020 Major League Baseball (MLB) draft was unusual in many aspects mainly due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The usual June event was delayed to July and the number of rounds for selecting players was dramatically reduced from 40 to 5. That meant instead of drafting 1268 players in 40 rounds, it was reduced to 160 players chosen from colleges and high schools in the U.S. and abroad. This represented a sharp reduction in amateur players making it into the MLB system. Not surprisingly, the CCBL and the Commodores fared very well. Of the 160 players selected who played in the Cape Cod Baseball 73 or 46% of the players picked with 9 being former Falmouth Commodores being drafted and 3 highly qualified players signing as free agents.

# CAPE COD BASEBALL LEAGUE AND THE FALMOUTH COMMODORES ARE BACK FOR 2021

# PLAY BALL! We in

June expect to hear this at the first home game of the Falmouth Commodores at Guv Fuller Field to open the 2021 Cape Cod Baseball League season. It has been a troubling year with the Covid-19 pandemic, which among many other things caused the cancellation of the 2020 CCBL season: the first time a season has been cancelled since 1945! Now with the availability of various high-efficacy vaccines and a community that is anxious to return to some level of normalcy, the Falmouth Commodores will be playing 40 games this season.

While many concerns regarding the Covid-19 virus linger, optimism is prevailing as the arrival of players from colleges across the county is expected in early-mid June. It is unclear what, if any, restrictions will remain in regards to occupancy limits, masking, and social distancing when attending Commodores games. However, we are hopeful that the outdoor venue as well as the vaccine availability will provide for a full and eventful season. So come see the Commodores this summer at Guv Fuller Field and see America's favorite pastime played by some of the best amateur players in the country.

# GUV FULLER FIELD IMPROVEMENTS 2021

The planned Guv Fuller Field renovation project scheduled for construction in 2020 got sidetracked due to the Covid-19 pandemic; however it is on track for construction in September of 2021. The original approvals of the funds from the Community Preservation Committee (CPC) (approved in December 2019) and the Falmouth Town Meeting (delayed until September 2020) was for an amount thought to be more than sufficient to cover the entire project. However, contruction cand material costs dramatically increased during the pandemic resulting in insufficient funding following the bidding process. Tremendous flexibility shown by the CPC and the Town were exhibited as an urgent funding request was approved by the CPC for an additional \$314,045 bringing the total funding of the project to \$1,055,336. Final approval is anticipated at the Falmouth Town Meeting scheduled for June. The major renovation will include new safety fencing, dugouts and visitor bleachers. All new walkways and dugouts will meet the guidelines for the American Disability Act, a feature that did not previously exist.


# 2020 COMMODORE HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES



## KEVIN NEWMAN

Kevin Newman is currently a shortstop with the Pittsburgh Pirates. He was drafted in 2015 by Pittsburgh in the first round as the 19th overall pick. Kevin is originally from Poway, CA and attended the University of Arizona. Kevin was a Falmouth Commodore in 2013 & 2014 with a batting average of .375 and .380,

respectively. He is the only CCBL player ever to have won the Batting Title 2 years in a row. Since joining the major leagues in 2018 Kevin has an overall batting average of .293 in 584 at bat appearances with 12 HRs.



## CLIFF PENNINGTON

Cliff is an 11-year Major League Baseball veteran, playing from 2008-2018. He played for 5 different teams while making his debut with the Oakland Athletics, the same team that drafted him in the first round, 21st overall. Cliff was born and raised in Corpus Christi, TX, and attended Texas A&M University as a baseball player, where he is currently

an assistant coach. As a Falmouth Commodore in 2004, Cliff helped lead the team to the divisional championship. Cliff impacted the team with both his advanced defensive prowess at SS and solid contributions with the bat, hitting .277 with 3 HRs, 21 RBIs, and 21 stolen bases.




