This year Military Appreciation Night will be held on Friday, June 30th at Guv Fuller Field (located at 790 Main Street in Falmouth, behind the Gus Canty Rec Center). The rain date will be Friday, July 14th.

Active military personnel and veterans will take the field at 5:45pm for a recognition ceremony before the Commodores game against the Brewster Whitecaps. The United States Coast Guard Honor Guard will be in attendance to present the colors.

Past and present military members will receive a discount on Commodores' merchandise purchased at the Sports Shack that evening and can enter for a raffle drawing. A fence of ribbons will be in place to honor military loved ones.

Everyone attending the game is welcome to wear a red shirt to the game and every Friday game. All of the teams in the Cape Cod Baseball League celebrate Red Shirt Friday to recognize and support our troops in harm's way.
