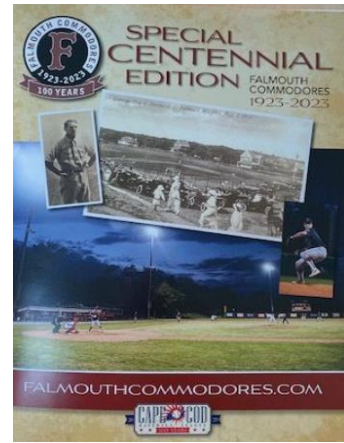
❖ In the event of rain, the Celebration will be held on July 21st. Same time, same place.

SPECIAL EDITION CENTENNIAL PROGRAM BOOK

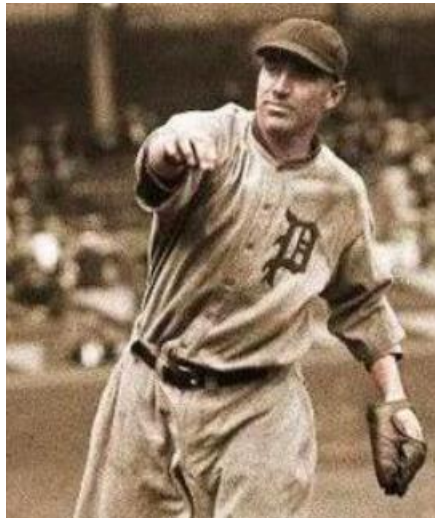
