



FALMOUTH COMMODORES TO HOLD CENTENNIAL COMMUNITY EVENT ON JULY 15th

Falmouth, MA, July 6, 2023 – The Falmouth Commodores are celebrating 100 years as an organized baseball team this year. To recognize this milestone, they will be holding a Centennial Celebration open to the public from 3-5:30pm on July 15th at Guv Fuller Field.

The event will include player autographs, meet Homer (the Commodores' mascot), a dunk tank, giant games, and prizes. Puffy Elvis, the local band comprised of teachers and guest performers, will play family-friendly music throughout the event. Hotdogs will be available for 25 cents (1923 prices) and local food trucks, Bo Beeps, Emma's Portable Pizza Oven, and Sea Scoops will be onsite.

The Commodores' Sports shack, located at the Guv Fuller Field behind home plate, will be open during the Centennial Celebration. Anyone purchasing \$100 or more of merchandise on July 15th, will be given a free Commodores' centennial pin. The Sport Shack will also offer the opportunity to win a centennial tee shirt or centennial hat. These offers are available until the top of the 7th inning or while supplies last, whichever comes first.

The Centennial Celebration is a free event, open to the Falmouth and surrounding communities. Those attending are encouraged to bring their chairs and enjoy the music. Fans may stay after the celebration to watch the Falmouth Commodores play the Chatham Anglers. In the event of rain, the Centennial Celebration will be held on July 21st from 3-5:30pm.

A Special Edition Commodores Centennial Program Guide is available and will be sold during home games at the Sports Shack and intern tent. This 74-page guide is filled with articles, Commodores' photos from the past century, interviews with alumni MLB players, and people who contributed to the organization over the years.

The Falmouth Commodores are one of 10 teams comprising the Cape Cod Baseball League. The Cape Cod Baseball League, recognized as one of the nation's premiere collegiate summer leagues, was originally founded in 1923. When it was formed, the league consisted of only four teams – Falmouth, Chatham, Hyannis, and Osterville.
